- in an environment free of daily hassles,
- to allow science to advance on unforeseen paths.

The fellows came from **more than 30 countries**, including developing countries, and **stayed between one and several months**.




# 2021-2023 theme: "The past, present and future of food, climate and sustainability". ULB BriAS WUB


## 2024-2025 theme: Robots and Al as enablers or disablers of the UN SDGs
